<b>Paper-faced corner bead and trim</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Metal covered with paper</li> <li>• Attached to drywall corners using setting-type, taping, or all-purpose joint compound instead of nails.</li> <li>• Edge is finished with typical joint treatment system.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 90° and 135° squared, outside and inside corners</li> <li>• 90° and 135° rounded outside and inside corners</li> <li>• Where drywall abuts suspended ceilings, beams, plaster, masonry, and concrete walls</li> <li>• Around untrimmed door and window jambs</li> </ul>	Available in a full range of types and sizes, including outside corners in regular and bullnose profiles, offset corners, flexible metal corner tape, inside corners, inner cove, L-shaped trim, J-shaped trim, and reveal trim
<b>Flexible metal corner reinforcing tape</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Galvanized steel strips covered with tape that form a strong corner bead when folded</li> <li>• Applied with standard joint compound feathered at the edges for a smooth wall surface</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Durable corner protection for cathedral and drop ceilings, arches, and bay windows</li> <li>• Used to join drywall partition to plastered wall in remodeling</li> <li>• Used for repairing chipped and cracked corners</li> </ul>	Ensures straight, sharp corners on unusual angles
<b>Metal corner bead and trim</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Galvanized steel strips</li> <li>• Attached to drywall with nails or screws. Finished with standard joint compound feathered at the edges</li> </ul>	Same uses as paper-faced corner bead and trim	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Exposed nose of the bead helps prevent damage from impact and provides a screed for finishing</li> <li>• Available in various sizes and angles</li> </ul>
<b>Vinyl trim</b>	Vinyl plastic strips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applied where drywall terminates at exterior metal surfaces, such as window mullions, to help stop condensation damage</li> <li>• Same uses as paper-faced corner bead and trim</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Requires no finishing compound</li> <li>• Easily painted</li> </ul>
